



# Information about the third dose of Vaccine

The third dose of Vaccine is available for the general public. Eligible persons who would like to receive the vaccination, please wait patiently until the vaccination coupon arrives.

## Eligible persons

Those who meet the following requirements:

- People who have completed their 2nd dose of vaccination series
- In principle, at least 8 months\* have passed after completing their 2nd dose
  - ※ at least 6 months for healthcare workers and 7 months for elderly people
- People aged 18 years and older

## Period for receiving vaccinations

Until September 30, 2022 (also applies to 1st and 2nd dose)

## Vaccination Coupons delivery dates

### 【Current Schedule】

Second dose completion dates	Coupon delivery dates	Third dose starting dates
Elderly people: until July 15, 2021 Other: until June 20, 2021	Will be sent in two parts, January 17 and 24, 2022	February 2022
Elderly people: until August 15, 2021 Other: until July 15, 2021	Will be sent in two parts, February 14 and 21, 2022	March 2022
Elderly people: until September 15, 2021 Other: until August 15, 2021	March 11, 2022	April 2022

- Depending on the circumstances, the delivery period might be delayed.
- There may be a period when you have to wait to receive vaccination even after the coupon arrives. Please make a reservation after the “Third dose starting dates”

## The enclosed items

### Things to bring on the day of vaccination

- ① (Left side) Certificate of Vaccination (Right side) Pre-vaccination Screening Questionnaire form with printed Vaccination Coupon

Please fill out the required items on the Pre-vaccination Screening Questionnaire on the right side and bring along your ID. After the vaccination, it will be recorded on the certificate on the left side, so please do not remove it.

- ② Notification (A4 double-sided, 1 sheet)

## Cross-vaccination

Receiving a different type of vaccine from the first and second dose is called “cross-vaccination”. Since the supply ratio of the vaccine to be used (Pfizer and Takeda/Moderna) is different from the first and second dose, please consider the “cross-vaccination” approach. ## Mass Vaccination

### ■ Vaccination Sites

- February: Naka Shoubousho Chuuou Bunsho, Aeon Town Yokkaichi Tomari, Health Plaza  
March : Naka Shoubousho Chuuou Bunsho, Aeon Town Yokkaichi Tomari, Health Plaza, Chuuou Dai-2 Taiikukan  
From April: Naka Shoubousho Chuuou Bunsho, Aeon Town Yokkaichi Tomari, Health Plaza, Chuuou Dai-2 Taiikukan, Jibasan Mie

■ **Type of vaccine administered:** Takeda/Moderna (For the time being)

■ **Reservations starting date:** From January 19, 2022

■ **How to make a reservation:** You can make a reservation online or by calling the call center. Refer to the QR Code on the right side for reservation site and online reservation method.



**Online reservations are accepted mainly for the 3<sup>rd</sup> dose of vaccination. If you are unfamiliar with online method, a support desk is provided on the 1<sup>st</sup> floor of the general hall (Sougou Kaikan) weekdays from 8:30 to 17:15.**

## Individual Vaccination

Please refer to the QR Code on the right side for medical institutions that provide individual vaccination

■ **Type of vaccine administered:** Pfizer

■ **Reservations starting date:** From late January 2022

■ **Vaccination starting date:** From February 1, 2022



**Do not make a double reservation for mass and individual vaccination or make reservations at multiple medical institutions. We ask for your kind cooperation so that vaccination can be provided to those who wish to receive it.**

For people who wish to receive the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> dose

### ● Aged 12 years and older

Available at Mitaki General Hospital (*Mitaki Sougou Byouin*) and Yamanaka Gastroenterology Hospital (*Yamanaka Ichouka Byouin*). For reservation, please contact each medical institution directly.

### ● Aged 5 to 11 years old

Currently, children under the age of 12 are not eligible for vaccination. If the government approves it in the future, further details will be informed later.
